
# DERRIFORD URC NEWS LETTER

### **Godly Thought...**

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> August I finished a two part series on the wonderful vision of Ezekiel about the water flowing from the Temple in Ezekiel 47. We finished with the amazing news that because of Jesus and His Holy Spirit we are now the living water that flows from the temple into the world where God has placed us. As we see in John 7:

On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them."



We also went on to say that if we want this living water to flow from us, we first have to receive the Living Water that Jesus speaks about and to receive it we have to desire it and if we desire it, we have to seek Jesus with all our hearts, as Jeremiah says "we will find Him, when we seek Him with all our hearts". My question to everyone, including myself, is how much do we really desire and therefore seek

him? How much do we hunger and thirst for more of God in our lives, in our situations?

Of course, this is a personal question and a personal decision. We each have to walk in our own path with God.

We also need to remember that receiving is not everything, it is not enough. We also have to give this 'living water' away too. Like a glass being filled with water once it is full if we don't pour any out, we can't pour any more in! We looked at the Woman at the Well whom Jesus spoke to in John 4. What was the first thing she did after receiving this living water from Jesus? She went and told everyone in her village, she gave it away! And they all wanted Jesus' Living Waters as well. They believed in the Messiah for themselves and received their own Living Water!

We need to receive it, by seeking God with all our hearts and give it away. You know, how we do this is not rocket science. We pray, we ask God, we read our Bibles, we get involved in church life and of course we worship Him (privately and corporately). We put time into the relationship between us and God and like any relationship that we invest in it grows and blossoms. Then to give this Living Water out, we become what Christ became, a servant to all. We care, love, serve the world, the community, the church where God has placed us and we share the gospel.

So, do you want all that Jesus has for you? Do you want to be filled with this Living Water? The call is yours and it's not a once in a lifetime thing – we need to continue this process time and time again! Being filled and filled and filled and then releasing and releasing and releasing.

This month's services will be led by:


